



INTEREST FREE STATUS FOR MEDICAL RESIDENTS



You are not required to pay interest or make payments (interest free status) on your Alberta Student Loans while you are completing medical residency training.



Definition of “medical resident”

A “medical resident” means a physician who is engaged in medical residency training recognized by:

- The College of Family Physicians of Canada
- The Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, or
- A body equivalent to the colleges referred to above that is recognized by the Minister and is located outside of Canada



What do you have to do?

- You are responsible to advise EDULINX and/or your lending institutions that you are in medical residency training.
- You will be required to have your educational institution sign a Confirmation of Registration Form B or create a letter on school letterhead.
- The educational institution signing your Form B must be a designated school for Alberta Student Loan funding.
- You will need to submit the Form B or letter to EDULINX and/or your lending institutions holding your Alberta Student Loan each year.
