

Advanced Placement Courses (updated May 7, 2012)

The Advanced Placement program was developed and is sponsored by the College Entrance Examination Board, New York, New York. The Advanced Placement (AP) program provides course materials and examinations on introductory courses. Some high schools in Alberta offer some courses in the Advanced Placement program. Students who have successfully completed examinations in the program may apply for advance credit through individual assessment upon admission to a post-secondary institution. More information is available from the Office of the Registrar at each institution. Upon admission to UofA, UofC, MacEwan and MRU, all AP students will automatically receive advance standing (credit or placement) in approved courses where they have achieved AP grades of "4" or "5". At UofA, students will have the option of declining the awarded transfer credit on a course-by-course basis by a specified deadline. At UofL and ACAD, students have the option of receiving transfer credit for approved courses where they have achieved grades of "4" or "5", or of taking the UofL or ACAD course. Where specified credit is not indicated, students with AP credits will be evaluated individually. At all receiving institutions, at least one official AP transcript is required. Advance credit arrangements are in effect at the universities and private colleges with accredited degree programs listed in the following table.

Advanced Placement Courses

- ¹⁰ Students may receive credit for only one of ENGL 1xxx and 1900 at UofL.
- ¹¹ Student must take one of ENGL 204 or 205 at King's.
- ¹² Student will not also receive credit for HIST 111, 112 or AUHIS 201, 202 at UofA.
- ¹³ At UofA, students who are eligible for Advanced Placement may register in a senior course. In the case of Language other than English courses, students with Advanced Placement will be permitted to register in a senior level course after determination of their background qualifications for that course (interview, placement test, etc.). Students may also challenge a junior or senior course for credit via the Credit by Special Assessment route if they have appropriate qualifications and are eligible within the regulations.
- ¹⁴ Student will not also receive credit for POL S 101 at UofA.
- ¹⁵ Student cannot also receive credit for POLS 101 at MacEwan.
- ¹⁶ Student must present a grade of 4 or 5 to receive transfer credit at MacEwan.
- ¹⁷ Will not count towards Music requirements for Music majors.
- ¹⁸ Student will not also receive credit for PSYC 105 at MacEwan.
- ¹⁹ Student will not also receive credit for PSYCO 104 or 105 at UofA.
