STUDENTS ARE PLACED ON A CREW, LIVE ON A WILDFIRE BASE FOR THE SUMMER, AND MEET WITH DIFFERENT PROFESSIONALS TO TAKE PART IN HANDS-ON WORK PROJECTS AND EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCES. SOME OF THESE OPPORTUNITIES INCLUDE TRAIL BUILDING, STREAM ASSESSMENTS, TOURING A LUMBER MILL, HELICOPTER RIDES, TREE PLANTING, WILDFIRE TRAINING, BIRD BANDING, HABITAT RESTORATION AND SO MUCH MORE!
