## **High Prairie**

JFR Base Name: High Prairie Wildfire Base

**Distance from Nearest Town/City:** 4km

**Brief Description:** High Prairie camp consists of two bunkhouses (single room occupancy with AC), a large kitchen, warehouse, logistics shed, and bathroom house. This camp is often busy with multiple crews working at all times and helicopter activity when the fire hazard rises. High Prairie has amenities which include a few gyms, aquatic center, movie theater, and running trail. Ten min away is a bowling alley in Enilda. Being so close to Slave Lake allows for the opportunity of fishing or a beach day. The High Prairie area has a lot of Indigenous activities in the summer such as Pow Wows.

## Projects crews have completed in previous years:

- JC Park maintenance
- Wildfire lookout tower assent training and site work
- Tolko and or West Fraser mill tours
- Lesser Slave Bird Observatory work exchange
- When conditions are safe and favorable wildfire operations (suppression work, tour of bases and planes ect.)

The JFR program aims to run a crew in 9 of 10 forest management areas, annually rotating which area(s) do(es) not have a crew. Activities in each forest area will vary from year to year
